The Department is conducting a selection process among the eligible students for the Inter-University arts and cultural events to represent Cochin University of Science and Technology during the year 2024-25. Students from various Departments of the University, Constituent Colleges and Recognized Institutes can participate in the selection process.

MUSIC	Classical Vocal solo (Hindustani or Carnatic), Classical Instrumental Solo (Percussion), Classical Instrumental Solo (Non-Percussion), Light Vocal Solo, Western Vocal Solo, Group Song (Indian), Group Song (Western), Western Solo (Instrumental), Folk Orchestra
DANCE	Folk/Tribal Dance, Classical Dance
LITERARY EVENTS	Quiz, Elocution (English or Hindi), Debate(English or Hindi)
THEATRE	One Act Play, Skit, Mime, Mimicry
FINE ARTS	On the spot painting, Collage, Poster Making, Clay Modelling, Cartooning, Rangoli, Installation, Spot Photography, Mehandi

Guidelines:

- In the items, viz, mimicry, poster making, collage, cartooning, and spot photography, selection will be open to all, but those candidates who came in the first three places at the University level may get preference for the selection in the concerned items. Other candidates who haven't participated in interuniversity competitions can also participate in the selection process and may be selected based on the recommendation of the selection committee, based on outstanding performance.
- 2. For individual items with no competition at the University level, selection will be open to all.
- 3. For all team events, a university-level selection is to be conducted to formulate the University team for the inter-university competitions.
- 4. Selection will be conducted by the Director, Students Welfare, and the Department of Youth Welfare by appointing a panel of judges/experts. The events to be participated in will be decided by the Director after the selection.
- 5. The decision of the selection committee (i.e, Judges/Experts and Director, Youth Welfare) will be final.
- 6. The selected participants are liable to obey rules and regulations issued by the Department of Youth Welfare, University, Concerned Colleges and Association of Indian Universities.
- 7. Only students, who are less than 25 years of age can participate. The multiplicity of talents will get preference for to be selected. The selected candidates should participate in multiple events since the total number of contingents is restricted.
